With over 35 years of leadership, consulting, and systems integration experience, having served in various senior executive-level positions, Dr. Linda Singh offers a blend of public and private sector experience that spans health, defense, state, and local government in 2010, doubling the size of the business.

As the founder and Chief Executive Officer of Kaleidoscope Affect, LLC, Dr. Singh provides leadership and management consulting and strategic advisory services for various public and private sector clients. Dr. Singh served as the Inaugural Leader-In-Residence for Towson University, focusing on creating the foundation for leadership culture and common leader competencies across the campus. Previously, Dr. Singh was the Interim Executive Director and CEO of TEDCO, focused on investing and helping to grow early-stage technology and life sciences companies to fuel economic development and growth. Prior to that, she served as a Major General in the Maryland National Guard, dedicating more than 38 years of service. As the Adjutant General and Cabinet Secretary, she was responsible for the Maryland Military Department. As part of her military role, she worked with senior-level officials at ministerial and ambassador levels in Estonia and Bosnia, developing country strategies under the Department of Defense State Partnership Program. Dr. Singh retired from Accenture in 2016, and she was a Managing Director in the Health and Public Service North America Operating Unit, where she served for 21 years.

Dr. Singh serves on the board of directors for WaveDancer (WAVD), Westat, and the Capella University Board of Trustees a Strategic Education, Inc. (NASDAQ: STRA)) organization and is a member of the Cybersecurity Forum Initiative. She served on the public board of Howard Bancorp, which was acquired in early 2022, and the board of Easterseals DC MD VA, and Headstrong. Dr. Singh mentors, coaches, and speaks on leadership, diversity, adversity, career transition, and issues plaguing women and veterans in the workplace. She holds a bachelor's degree in business, a Master's of Business Administration, a Master's of Strategic Studies, and a Ph.D. in Industrial and Organizational Psychology. She is the author of "*Moments of Choice: Moments of Choice: My path to leadership*" and "*What's in Your Box? Designing the Life You Want*".

Dr. Singh is a certified Project Management Professional (PMP), Professional Certified Coach (PCC), and Gallup Strengths Coach. CCMBA *History*

The historical background of CCMBA finds its roots with The Concerned Black Women of Calvert County, Inc. and Calvert County's Branch of the NAACP. The Concerned Black Women of Calvert County, Inc. and the NAACP of Calvert County both sponsored committees that addressed minority business development in Calvert County. The NAACP's Economic Development committee helped to establish a minority business group in the 1980's. In 2004, CBW, Inc. chartered a special Business Directory committee that eventually evolved into CBW's Minority Business Committee – a standing committee of the organization. Out of CBW's business directory committee, the Inaugural Calvert County Minority Business Directory was completed for 2005-2006.

In June 2006, CBW and the Calvert County Department of Economic Development hosted a kickoff planning meeting for the development of a Calvert County Minority Business Organization. All businesses were encouraged to attend to help develop an independent organization whose focus is to support minority business owners living in Calvert County and the Southern Maryland region. In January 2007, after six months of planning, the Calvert County Minority Business Alliance “officially” commenced. The mission of CCMBA is to educate, assist, and develop its members by promoting the growth and retention of minority business in Calvert County and Southern Maryland; provide training and education opportunities; act as a liaison to local, state and federal policy makers concerning minority business needs including recommending programs and services that benefit this segment of the business community as well as increase the County's business tax base; and provide opportunities to market and expand one's business.
